

# Segway Guide

This is a brand-new position starting 2019. Segway Guides will facilitate up to 4 tours per day. Segway Guides must have excellent leadership skills and have detailed eye for safety and guest management. Segway Guides must be comfortable working alone, as this tour runs off-site. Segway Guides will need a valid driver's licence and be comfortable driving a company vehicle with a small trailer attached.



Segway Guides can expect part-time work in the shoulder season (May, June, September) and full-time work in peak season (July, August). Additional shoulder season hours may be available if applicants are willing to cross-train in other departments.

## Essential Duties:

- Check-in guests using a mobile app
- Perform Segway orientation with guests
- Facilitate Segway tours while providing interpretive information about the area
- Maintain tour logs
- Drive Segways to and from our main site

## Qualifications:

- No prior experience necessary. All training will take place on site
- Up to date First Aid Certification
- Drivers licence
- Must be physically fit (Guides will need to load and unload Segways from a trailer)
- Willing to work in all weather
